VOICELESS ANIMAL CRUELTY INDEX 2017

Overall Rank 33

Turkey was a *poor* performer under the Voiceless Animal Cruelty Index (VACI) 2017.

Producing Cruelty

Rank 32

Turkey slaughters around 14.8 land-based animals per person / year, which is higher than the global average of 9.7. The country's dependency on farmed animals is also higher than average, with around 4.6 farmed animals per person (compared with a global average of around 4). Factory farming is prevalent in poultry production. As with other Muslim countries, no data was available for pig meat production.

Consuming Cruelty

Rank 21

The Turkish diet contains a relatively low proportion of animal products, with around 32.5% of the average person's diet being made up of land-based animal protein (compared with a global average of 35.2%). This equates to each person consuming around 34.6g of land-based animal protein per day (compared with a global average of 26.7g).

Sanctioning Cruelty

Rank 34

Turkey was given an "E" under the Animal Protection Index (API) 2014, and was also a poor performer under the Sanctioning Cruelty category. According to the API 2014, Turkey has inadequate animal protection laws that are poorly implemented and enforced. It should be noted that positive amendments to Turkey's animal protection laws were implemented in 2014 and were not considered in the API's assessment.
