VOICELESS ANIMAL CRUELTY INDEX 2017

Overall Rank 18

Vietnam was a *marginally adequate* performer under the Voiceless Animal Cruelty Index (VACI) 2017.

Producing Cruelty

Rank 10

Vietnam slaughters around 5.6 land-based animals per person / year, which is lower than the global average of 9.7. The country's dependency on farmed animals is relatively low, with around 3.8 farmed animals per person (compared with a global average of around 4). Factory farming is prominent in poultry and pig production, and even on small-scale farms, severe confinement is common.

Consuming Cruelty

Rank 11

The Vietnamese diet contains a relatively low proportion of animal products, with around 30.9% of the average person's diet being made up of land-based animal protein (compared with a global average of 35.2%). This equates to each person consuming around 22.6g of land-based animal protein per day (compared with a global average of 26.7g). Vietnam has a long tradition of vegetarianism grounded in traditional Buddhist ethics.

Sanctioning Cruelty

Rank 45

Vietnam was given an "F" under the Animal Protection Index (API) 2014, and was also a poor performer under the Sanctioning Cruelty category.
